WHEREAS, the Yakima Rural County Library District Board of Trustees (doing business as Yakima Valley Libraries) has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2022; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees in the course of considering the budget for 2022 has reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined, in accordance with the provisions in RCW 27.12.050, that the revenue required for the maintenance of library service in the district is as shown in the 2022 budget, adopted November 15, 2021 by Resolution #21-011;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of and necessary to meet the expenses and obligations of Yakima Valley Libraries and that a substantial need exists for the property tax revenue to be increased in 2022 to support ongoing and capital library services operations;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the regular levy is \$8,344,566.10, which is a \$81,745.45-dollar increase from the 2021 levy amount and a 1% increase of that same 2021 levy amount, plus additional amounts allowed for new construction, annexations, and increase in state assessed values and eligible amount from the refund levy.


