A Resolution In the Matter of the 2023 Property Tax Levy For the Yakima Rural County Library District Above the "limit factor," up to 101 percent

RESOLUTION #22-014

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees for the Yakima Rural County Library District, doing business as Yakima Valley Libraries has met, considered and approved its budget for the calendar year 2023, according to the provisions of RCW 27.12.050 and Resolution #22-013; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, in the course of considering the budget for 2023 has reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that, due to increased expenditures, (day to day operations and capital projects), to carry on the services, operations and maintenance of the Library District, the Board of Trustees find there is a substantial need to increase the regular property tax levy rate above the rate of inflation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the limit factor for the regular levy for the calendar year of 2023 shall be 101 percent of the highest amount of regular property taxes that could have been lawfully levied in this taxing district in any year.
