WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of and necessary to meet the expenses and obligations of Yakima Valley Libraries and that a substantial need exists for the property tax revenue to be increased in 2025 to support ongoing and capital library services operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the regular levy is \$9,057,163, which is a \$88,417-dollar increase from the 2024 levy amount and a 1% increase of that same 2024 levy amount, plus additional amounts allowed for new construction, annexations, and increase in state assessed values and eligible amount from the refund levy.
