**RESOLUTION
25-013**

WHEREAS, the Yakima Rural County Library District Board of Trustees (doing business as Yakima Valley Libraries) has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees in the course of considering the budget for 2026 has reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined, in accordance with the provisions in RCW 27.12.050, that the revenue required for the maintenance of library service in the district is as shown in the 2026 budget, adopted November 19, 2025 by Resolution #25-011;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the best interest of and necessary to meet the expenses and obligations of Yakima Valley Libraries and that a substantial need exists for the property tax revenue to be increased in 2026 to support ongoing and capital library services operations;

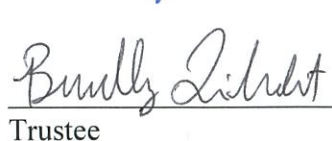
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the regular levy is \$9,257,183, which is a \$90,812-dollar increase from the 2025 levy amount and a 1% increase of that same 2025 levy amount, plus additional amounts allowed for new construction, annexations, and increase in state assessed values and eligible amount from the refund levy.

I, Mary MacKintosh, Secretary of the Yakima Rural County Library District, do hereby certify that the Yakima Rural County Library District Board of Trustees of said Library District and appearing in the minutes of a meeting held on the 19th day of November 2025, requesting the Board of Commissioners of Yakima County to levy taxes as follows:

Regular levy request in the amount of \$9,257,183 which is a \$90,812.11-dollar increase from the 2025 levy amount and a 1% increase of that same 2025 levy amount, plus any amount allowed for new construction, refunds, and increase in state assessed values.
